

- The fall semester runs from October 17 - December 13th
- ✓ Classes are held at Centenary United Methodist Church in Winston-Salem on Thursday afternoons, from 5:50 - 6:30.
- Performance opportunities are approximately 1-2 times per semester. Some of these include singing in a concert with the other 5 choirs!
- A schedule is sent out ahead of time so that parents can plan ahead.
- There is also an opportunity for parents to volunteer, such as helping to sit in and chaperone, or to provide refreshments when needed.

Centenary UMC:

- We use the entrance at the BACK of the church, which is next to the back of the Public Library downtown.
- You can park on the street (street signs apply), or in the small lot directly across from the back entrance. Enter the church inside the <u>41/2 street entrance</u> closest to the parking lot.
- Singer check-in will be just inside the Welcome Area. Due to lack of space and fire code parents are to leave and return for pick-up. *The Public Library is literally next door and a great place to go/take siblings while you wait.

The purpose of the Dragonflies Choir is to introduce young singers to choral music through vocal discovery, creative movement, & light performances.

- ③ A Deposit of \$50 includes the class materials and the shirt which is due upon registration. Due to small class size, registrations are guaranteed on a first-come, first-served basis with paid deposit.
- Payments: An \$85 tuition fee is <u>due by October 1st</u>.
 *After October 1st, tuition fee increases to 100.00.
- You can opt to register for BOTH the Fall and Spring Semesters <u>for a</u> <u>discount</u>: \$81 registration Fee, \$81 due by October 1st; third payment of \$81 due by November 1st. *Spring Semester is March 20th - May 7th
